CHALLENGE

Recent works from a security perspective include some 9,000 linear metres of 2.4m and 3 metre welded mesh and profile mesh systems to high security areas.

Various heights, colour options and gate / access solutions have been required and design input has been provided by us for non-invasive ground mounting systems in SSSI areas, as well as an extensive requirement for earthed fencing adjacent to high voltage UG power lines feeding the vent shaft installations.
